

Safety Practices for Return to Campus



Masks

- All persons are **required to wear face coverings**, in the form of a mask, when indoors in Institute buildings.
- The face coverings **must cover the nose and mouth**.
- Unacceptable face coverings include: **scarves, bandanas or snoods; face coverings with “direct exhaust valves”** and face coverings that are disrespectful and inappropriate for a campus environment.
- Some students may have a medical exemption from wearing a face covering. If you are in this category you are required to **register this with the Disability Service**.
- If you have this exemption you **must maintain 2M distance at all times** from other persons while indoors.
- Students who refuse to wear a mask in class (unless they have a medical exemption) may be asked to leave the class which could lead to disciplinary consequences if they do not comply. **The lecturer reserves the right to end the class if the student refuses to wear the mask or leave if asked to do so.**



Clean & Disinfect

- Anti viral wipes will be provided in all teaching areas. Please help by **cleaning down your seats, desks and workstations** before and after class.



Hand Sanitisation

- Wash your hands **regularly with soap**.
- **Hand sanitisation stations** are being provided at the entrances to all buildings and at regular intervals around the campus.



Social Distancing & Crowd Control

- Movement of people into, within and out of buildings will require your cooperation to avoid congestion. We would ask you to follow all the directional signs on campus. **Please keep to the left.**
- We would ask all students to **return home** when they have completed their daily classes. Students who have no timetabled in-person events on a given day will be requested not to attend the campus so as to manage overall on campus numbers. We hope that this situation can be revisited after the 22nd of October but until then, time spent on the campus should be limited to class time.
