



Dear Student,

In order to complete the pre-placement documentation necessary for clinical placement, please note the following list of documents that you should bring with you on your first week.

- Two forms of identification, one that must be photographic, for example, birth certificate, driving licence, passport.
- Police clearance documents **if** you have lived abroad for more than six months since the age of sixteen. In this case, you will need to contact the Embassy of the country you have lived in to organise your police clearance. If you have this completed before you commence your course, it will speed up the Garda Vetting process (*please refer to the Garda Vetting documentation*).
- Immunisation records (*please refer to the HSE Occupational Health Department correspondence*)
- Bank details – for clinical placement expenses and allowances.
