Dear Student,

Congratulations on achieving your place on this course of study. You will be seen individually in DKIT in September.

- You will need to provide immunisation records in relation to vaccination for Tuberculosis (BCG) and Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR). These records will be held in either Local Health Offices or General Practitioner (GP) Please see enclosed **Immunisation Queries and Records** with advice and contact details of where you can access these records where available. Please note we request documented evidence of **two** doses of MMR vaccination. It may take a period of time to obtain these records but they are required. Immunisation records can be presented to us during your appointment in DKIT in September
- If you have previously received Hepatitis B vaccinations please also provide documentation of this and of subsequent blood test for Hep B immunity.

If you are on Student Midwife programme, in accordance with HSE HR Circular 012/2009 Implementation of Recommendations of Report on The Prevention of Transmission of Blood Borne Diseases in the Health Care Setting, you must bring valid proof of identity (passport or driving licence) to your appointment in DKIT in September.

Please note all records should be presented only to Occupational Health personnel, and will be retained in confidence. If you have any queries in relation to the above please contact us at the above number.
