Project Number & Title:	<p>Project 3</p> <p>Green Campus Stakeholder Analysis</p>
Project Details	<p>The <i>Green Campus Programme</i> promotes partnership and community engagement to enhance sustainability in third level institutions (An Taisce 2021). In 2012, Dundalk Institute of Technology achieved <i>Green Flag</i> status but after failing to reapply, was subsequently de-registered from the programme. The aim of this project is to examine the possibility of reinstating the green campus initiative in DKIT. In order to achieve this, buy-in will be required across the entire DKIT community from student representatives, staff and senior management and a green campus committee formed.</p> <p>The purpose of this project is to begin the scoping process by undertaking Stakeholder Mapping in preparation for the seven steps (www.greencampusireland.org/seven-steps). This project aims to determine the level of interest across stakeholders and identifying key individuals and groups who could potentially play a role in the future of DKIT's green campus initiative.</p>
Profile of Candidate	<p>The ideal candidate is an undergraduate student from any discipline with an interest in sustainability and environmental issues. The candidate should be comfortable undertaking in-depth interviews and basic IT skills are essential.</p>
