Policy on Children* in DkIT Library

The facilities, and services provided by the Library are designed primarily to meet the research and curricular needs of the DkIT community.

While this environment is not designed for children, we do recognise that, on occasion, DkIT readers may need to bring children with them when visiting the Library. Children must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or guardian.

Primarily for the safety and security of children and also in consideration of others using the Library please be aware that:

- Parents/guardians are responsible for the health, safety and security of children while in the Library
- Children must be supervised by a parent or guardian at all times while in the Library
- Parents or guardians must ensure that children under their supervision behave in an appropriate manner and do not misuse facilities
- Persons under 18 years old may not use Library computers, Wi-Fi or other services
- The Library assumes no liability for unaccompanied children. If a child is left unattended in the Library staff will notify Campus Security
- Any one causing disturbance to other readers or acting inappropriately will, regardless of age, will be asked to leave the Library
- Parents or guardians of unsupervised children will not be allowed to use the Library and will have access rights withdrawn

*Children in this context defined as non-library members who are under 16 years old.
