Certificate in Foundation Studies

This programme is designed for students who:

- ightarrow Have attended secondary (high school) education in their home country.
- ightarrow Need to complete an international foundation year (IFY) to qualify for higher education.
- ightarrow Need a programme that prepares them for year 1.
- → Speak English to a more advanced level, perhaps because they went to an English-speaking school, or come from a place where English is widely spoken as a second language.
- → Would like to get a flavour of a year 1 programme, e.g., by taking an elective in Business, Science, Engineering or Computing.

Duration: 1 academic year (2 semesters)

Start Dates: September - June

Qualification Received: NFQ Level 6 Certificate (60 Credits)

English Entry Requirement: IELTS 4.5 or Grade C in iGCSE/GCSE English (or equivalent in an internationally recognised English exam) When students arrive at DkIT, they do a quick placement test to assess their level of English.

Tuition Fees: €7,375 (including mandatory sports facilities fee)

Progression Pathway*: Completion of this programme will enable students to progress to Year 1 of their selected Bachelor programme, subject to achieving the following grades in Foundation:

- \rightarrow 40% (entry to Year 1, Level 7 Bachelor programme)
- ightarrow 60% (entry to Year 1 of Level 8 Bachelor programme)
- ightarrow 65% (entry to Level 8 Higher Diploma programme)

Students who achieve 70%+ in the Certificate in Foundation Studies may be eligible to receive a $\leq 1,000$ academic merit scholarship off their degree programme tuition fees in DkIT.
