Regional Development Centre

The New Frontiers Programme is funded by Enterprise Ireland and co-funded by the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) under Ireland's European Structural and Investment Funds Programmes 2014-2020.

Occupancy in the RDC has increased from 71% in January 2016 to 93% in March 2016. Occupancy rate in the Millmount Development Centre is 81% year to date.

Based on results for the first six months to February 2016, it is estimated that the total over expenditure against the plan will be \in 360k; this would mean a deficit of \notin 693k for the full year 2015/16. The Devolved Grant already received of \notin 750k is not included in these figures.

The report on the Engineering School is in progress and will be completed by June 2016.

The report on Research is due by the end of April 2016.

The review of the programmes schedules and timetables does not indicate any further savings.

The need for significant Capital investment in the Institute was discussed in some detail. The Chairman read an excerpt from a letter to the HEA which included:

- The need for targeted investment in the Institute.
- A redundancy scheme.
- Capital funding for areas in need of renovation.
- Additional investment to aid maintain student numbers.
